Transportation Links

Buses* Currently, the local buses 7, 45, 37, 39 enter the entrance of the estate, so the nearest stop is some 500m away from the school.

Rail* There is no rail station in Waterlooville, the nearest rail stations are in Bedhampton, Havant and Cosham (4-4.5miles from school), therefore it is unlikely that either staff or pupils will travel to school this way

Roads* The Berewood site is accessed from a roundabout with Maurepas Way the A3 to the south and Hambledon Rd, a road which connects Denmead to Waterlooville. Within the site the school is accessed by travelling down Grainger Street, onto Kentidge St before turning into Kentidge Way, these roads are all still to be adopted by the highway authority. The Berewood site has close links to the M27 and A3

Walking Routes* Pupils walk along Hambledon Road and the new estate roads: Grainger Street, Kentidge St and Kentidge Way, all of these roads have footpaths on at least one side of the road and there are good footpaths to access to town centre.

Cycling Routes* There are no dedicated cycle routes on new development yet.
