Monday	<p>English</p> <p>This week we will be looking at the book 'The Storm Whale'. Before you read the whole story, we would like you to read only the first sentence to your children - "Noi lived with his dad and six cats by the sea". Once you have read this sentence to your children ask them to draw (using chalk, charcoal, pencils or pens) what they imagine when they hear this sentence. Read the sentence as many times to your children as they need you to. What does dad look like? Who is Noi? Where does he live? Tuesday	<p>English</p> <p>Using the story of 'The Storm Whale' re-read the opening sentence aloud, then share the illustration of Noi eating his breakfast and his father collecting his coat. Discuss with the children what they notice as they explore the illustration: • What do you like and dislike about what you see? How does this picture add to or change what you thought before? Now look at the next image of Noi and read the accompanying text (see following slides). Encourage your children to talk about how Noi might be feeling as his dad goes off to work.
