An Inukshuk in the shape of a person signifies safety, hope and friendship. Using coloured paper, create your own Inukshuk. These solar storms blow a stream of particles towards Earth, called the solar wind. The particles in the solar wind have lots of energy. The energetic solar wind particles collide with the Earth's atmosphere and hit oxygen and nitrogen atoms. Some of the energy from the particles in the solar wind gets passed to the oxygen and nitrogen atoms. This makes the oxygen and nitrogen atoms glow different colours. The result is an amazing explosion that fills the sky, better known as the Aurora Borealis or Northern Lights.
