### **The Platinum Jubilee Celebration**

As you are aware, this year is the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. To mark this extraordinary event we will be holding a garden party on our school field. The party will take place on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May at 1:30pm. We are hoping that as many of you will be able to attend as possible. We are seeing this not only as a celebration for the Jubilee but also as a celebration for our school community to get together after what has been such a long time.

Berewood is such a different school from what it was before the pandemic started, it has grown in size and is very nearly full! Meaning we have 415 pupils. Due to the size of our school, the afternoon will be need to be run to strict timings to ensure all our pupils are kept safe.

The afternoon will start at 1:30, when the gates will be opened to parents/carers. Please feel free to bring blankets and picnic chairs, food and drink (non-alcoholic), games etc. You will be signed in by a member of the Senior Leadership Team and once everyone is in, we will lock the gates behind you. Each year group will be allocated an area on the field, this is so it is easier for the children to find you. Please be mindful that there is little to no shade on our field and you will want to ensure you have adequate sun protection.

Once everyone is in and the gates are locked, the children will be brought out and find you. If you are unable to attend, we will ensure pupils without a family member will be looked after by school staff, enjoying the afternoon with them.

From then on, it is a time for you to enjoy time together chatting, playing games and relaxing.

At about 3:00pm the children who need to be collected as usual, will be taken into school and the rest of you will be free to leave once the gates have been reopened at the usual end of day collection time. Toilets will be available to adults and children, and will be clearly signposted, but there will be a strict one in one out policy. This is to ensure we do not have people inside the school building.
