A twist on the popular nursery rhyme 'Wheels on the Bus' featuring dinosaurs instead. Dinosaur obsessed children will love singing along to this book.



SANDALL, ELLIE Balancing Bernie

Bernie loves to balance things on his nose. One day another dog asks Bernie to balance him, and then more and more doggies of all shapes and sizes come along. This story bounces along with a great rhythm to share aloud.



WHAITE, MICHAEL 100 Birds

A firm favourite for every bird lover. The lovely illustrations depict all different kinds of birds packed into its pages. Great descriptions of the birds - I wonder which one is your favourite?

Mabel is trying to find her family the perfect pet but it is far harder than she realised! A wonderful rhyming text which would be great to share. Which animal would make your perfect pet?



HENDRA, SUE

I Spy Island

Vibrant illustrations bring this story of friendship to life, all set on a desert island. Another winner from this successful author and illustrator duo.



MURRAY, LILY

That Dinosaur Has Talent!

A wonderful story about overcoming shyness and being able to discover your talent through friendship. Great for all dinosaur lovers.



TAYLOR, SEAN

Monster! Hungry! Phone!

This story will make you giggle, as the hungry monster rings various wrong numbers in his effort to get food. Will he ever get through to the right person? Great to read out loud, a monster voice is essential.

Dragons Don't Share


