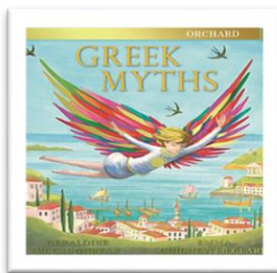
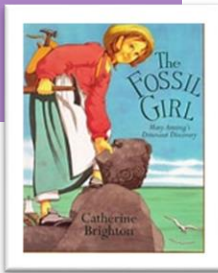

This is to ensure secure knowledge of all phases and spelling rules.

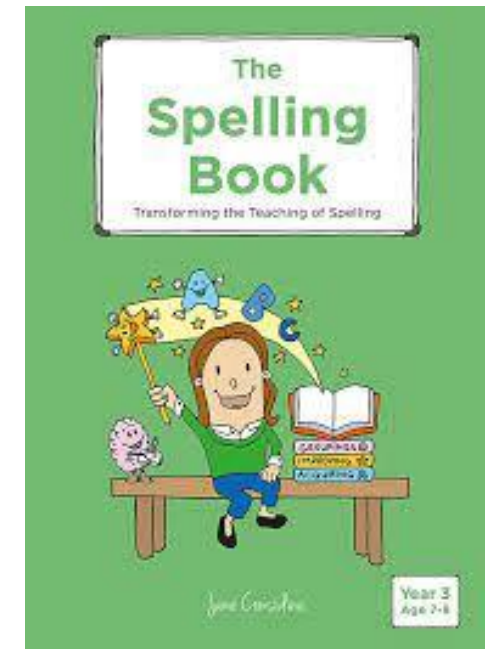
We will be sending home weekly spellings for the children to practise and apply in their writing.
