


In Year 4, we meet parents at the door unless we are told otherwise. Children in clubs walk down to meet the club leaders at the end of day.

We believe that homework is important: it supports their learning in school, helps prepare them for the next step in education and teaches them valuable organisational skills. If children are not able to complete their homework at home, then they will complete it at school during playtime.



Multiplication Tables Check



<u>Updates will be on the school</u> website

Children in English schools take a Multiplication Tables Check in Year 4. This is an assessment of the child's proficiency and speed in their tables and is carried out on a computer or laptop.

The Multiplication Check week will be in June 2024. The children have to answer 25 questions and have 6 seconds to answer each question.

The Multiplication Check is not about the children passing or failing but is about them having the knowledge to access their maths more easily. We don't see them as a one-off period in the school calendar but as a part of the overall teaching your child receives throughout their whole time at primary school.

We aim to ensure your child is as prepared as they can be to minimise any stress they may feel about the assessments.

Helping your child learn and recall their tables at speed will really help them feel more confident within Maths lessons.

We encourage using TTRockStars each week at home as well as in school.
