Kit List

Suitable clothing	Children should wear long trousers (not jeans) and a long sleeved T-shirt for protection from stings and bites. Layers of old clothing are best as they protect from the cold. Please note: forest school clothes will get dirty!
Suitable footwear	-in wet weather wellington boots with 2 pairs of warm socks -in drier weather old trainers
Hat	sunhat or warm woolly hat depending on the weather
Wet weather clothing	waterproof trousers and coat Please note: waterproofs are very important as we will be outside even in heavy rain! They can also help keep you warm on colder days and help to keep you clean.
